GENERAL NOTES

- DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, STANDARD DRAWINGS, STANDARD DRAWING NO. 10 AND THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS
- NO WORK SHALL BE UNDERTAKEN WITHOUT OBTAINING THE NECESSARY PERMITS
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO TAKE ALL PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES TO PROTECT ANY UNDERGROUND UTILITIES SHOWN. AND ANY LINES OR UTILITIES
- 4. TRIM EDGE OF EXISTING PAVEMENT WHERE NEW PAVEMENT JOINS TO A SMOOTH, STRAIGHT LINE. CONSTRUCT MATCH—UP PAVING AS SHOWN ON PLAN AND OVERLAY PAVING AS DIRECTED IN THE FIELD TO PRODUCE A SMOOTH SECTION.
- 5. IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TO CLEAR THE RIGHT OF WAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAW AS IT AFFECTS EACH UTILITY, INCLUDING IRRIGATION LINES AND APPURTENANCES AT NO COST
- 6. IN PAVEMENT OVERLAY AREAS, DISTRESSED EXISTING PAVEMENT SHALL BE REMOVED AND REPLACED AS DIRECTED BY THE INSPECTOR PRIOR TO OVERLAYING
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE TRENCHING FOR CABLE TELEVISION WITH OTHER TRENCHING WITHIN THE PROJECT.
- 8. ANY TRAFFIC CONTROL STRIPING OBLITERATED AND/OR BADLY WORN DURING CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE RESTORED BY THE CONTRACTOR WITHIN FIVE DAYS AFTER NOTIFICATION FROM THE CITY INSPECTORS.
- 9. FINAL STRIPING FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL AND/OR PAVEMENT MARKING TO BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE DEVELOPER.
- 10. ALL FLAGGED ELEVATIONS SHALL BE STAKED IN THE FIELD BY THE PRIVATE ENGINEER.
- 11. THE PRIVATE ENGINEER SIGNING THIS PLAN IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ASSURING THE ACCURACY AND ACCEPTABILITY OF THE WORK HEREON. IN THE EVENT OF DISCREPANCIES ARISING DURING CONSTRUCTION, THE PRIVATE ENGINEER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DETERMINING AN ACCEPTABLE SOLUTION AND REVISING THE PLANS FOR APPROVAL BY THE CITY.
- 12. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL IN A LOCATION REQUEST TO UNDERGROUND SERVICE ALERT (U.S.A.), PHONE #1-800-422-4133, TWO WORKING DAYS BEFORE DIGGING. NO CONSTRUCTION PERMIT WILL BE ISSUED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT INVOLVING EXCAVATION FOR UNDERGROUND FACILITIES UNLESS THE APPLICANT HAS BEEN PROVIDED AN INQUIRY IDENTIFICATION NUMBER BY U.S.A.
- 13. THE DEVELOPER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PRESERVING OR RE-ESTABLISHING AND REFERENCING SURVEY MONUMENTS DESTROYED. DISTURBED OR BURIED AS A RESULT OF CONSTRUCTION SHOWN HEREON.
- 14. ON ALL AREAS WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY WHERE THE FILL IS ONE (1) FOOT OR GREATER, A LETTER WILL BE REQUIRED FROM THE SOILS ENGINÉER, CERTIFYING THE COMPACTION OF THE FILL BELOW SUBGRADE, PRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF THE CONSTRUCTION PERMIT/CUT SHEETS.
- 15. QUANTITIES SHOWN ARE FOR INFORMATION ONLY AND THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR ACCURACY.


