
- 1. NO PERSON SHALL PERFORM ANY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY OR INSTALL ANY OBJECTS WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY OR EASEMENTS OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE WITHOUT A VALID CONSTRUCTION PERMIT OR, A STREET OPENING PERMIT OR AN ENCROACHMENT PERMIT ISSUED BY THE CITY'S PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.
- 2. IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TO CLEAR THE RIGHT OF WAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF LAW AS IT AFFECTS EACH UTILITY INCLUDING IRRIGATION LINES AND APPURTENANCES AND AT NO COST TO THE CITY.
- THE PRIVATE ENGINEER SIGNING THESE PLANS IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ASSURING THE ACCURACY AND ACCEPTABILITY OF THE WORK HEREON. IN THE EVENT OF DISCREPANCIES ARISING DURING CONSTRUCTION, THE PRIVATE ENGINEER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DETERMINING AN ACCEPTABLE SOLUTION AND REVISING THE PLANS FOR APPROVAL BY THE CITY.
- QUANTITIES SHOWN ARE FOR INFORMATION ONLY AND THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR ACCURACY.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PRESERVING OR RE-ESTABLISHING AND REFERENCING SURVEY MONUMENTS DESTROYED, DISTURBED OR BURIED AS A RESULT OF CONSTRUCTION SHOWN HEREON.
- 6. SEE "ELECTRIC UTILITY PLANS" DWG. #U5-694264 FOR QUANTITY AND LOCATION OF REQUIRED ELECTRIC FACILITIES.
- 7. ALL FLAGGED ELEVATIONS SHALL BE STAKED IN THE FIELD.
- WHERE NEW PAVEMENT IS TO JOIN THE EXISTING PAVEMENT. THE EDGE OF THE EXISTING PAVEMENT SHALL BE TRIMMED IN A SMOOTH AND STRAIGHT LINE. CONSTRUCT MATCH-UP PAVING AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS AND OVERLAY PAVING AS DIRECTED IN THE FIELD TO PRODUCE A SMOOTH SECTION.
- ANY TRAFFIC CONTROL STRIPING OBLITERATED AND/OR BADLY WORN DURING CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE RESTORED BY THE CONTRACTOR WITHIN FIVE DAYS AFTER NOTIFICATION FROM THE CITY INSPECTORS.
- 10. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL IN A LOCATION REQUEST TO UNDERGROUND SERVICE ALERT (USA), PHONE #1-800-227-2600, TWO WORKING DAYS BEFORE DIGGING. NO CONSTRUCTION PERMIT WILL BE ISSUED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT INVOLVING EXCAVATION FOR UNDERGROUND FACILITIES UNLESS THE APPLICANT HAS BEEN PROVIDED AN INQUIRY IDENTIFICATION NUMBER BY U.S.A.
- 11. CONTRACTOR IS TO VERIFY EXISTING SEWER-ELEVATION PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.
- 12. LOCATION OF LATERALS TO BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD AT THE DIRECTION OF THE OWNER. AVOID CONFLICT WITH PROPOSED AND/OR EXISTING FACILITIES.

GENERAL NOTES FOR STREET TREE PLANTING AND RELOCATION

- 1. ALL RELATED WORK SHALL CONFORM TO THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT STANDARDS AND CITY OF RIVERSIDE STREET TREE POLICIES.
- 2. WHEN CALLING FOR INSPECTIONS CONTACT THE STREET TREE INSPECTOR A MINIMUM OF 48 HOURS IN ADVANCE AT (909)351-6126 TO SCHEDULE AN INSPECTION. A FIELD NOTICE WILL BE
- ISSUED AS WRITTEN APPROVAL FOR EACH STAGE OF INSPECTION. A VERBAL APPROVAL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTABLE. INSPECTIONS ARE REQUIRED: A. AFTER COMPLETION OF FINAL GRADING OF THE LOTS AND WHEN ALL UTILITY SERVICES AND SEWER LATERALS HAVE BEEN MARKED, BUT PRIOR TO DIGGING PLANT PITS. ALL FINAL
 - B. WHILE DIGGING PLANT PITS AND PLANTING/RELOCATING TREES; C. AFTER PLANTING AND ALL OTHER INDICATED OR SPECIFIED WORK HAS BEEN COMPLÉTED, FOR START OF MAINTENANCE;

STREET TREE LOCATIONS ARE TO BE SPOTTED IN THE FIELD BY THE STATE TREE IMSPECTOR;

- D. AT THE END OF THE MAINTENANCE PERIOD, THE CONTRACTOR/DEVELOPER SHALL CALL STREET TREE INSPECTOR AT (909)351-6126 FOR A FINAL ACCEPTANCE INSPECTION IN ORDER TO BE RELEASED FROM MAINTENÁNCE. DEVELOPERS BONDS WILL NOT BE RELEASED UNTIL AFTER RECEIPT OF WRITTEN NOTIFICATION FROM THE CITY THAT THE TREES PASS FINAL INSPECTION AND THE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT IS ASSUMING MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES.
- 3. ALL STREET TREES ARE TO BE PLANTED PRIOR TO OCCUPANCY.
- 4. THE DEVELOPER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO ACCEPTABLY MAINTAIN ALL PLANTINGS FOR A MINIMUM PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR.
- 5. STREET TREE PLANTING SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

STREET NAME BOTANICAL NAME/COMMON NAME A. CITRUS AVENUE WASHINGTONIA FILITERA PALMS

APPROX. *NUMBER MIN. SPACING REQUIRED SIZE RELOCATE Z EA. AT PROJECT SITE, RELOCATE ZEA. TO WITHIN 2 MILES OF SITE, 13 EXISTING TO REMAIN IN PLACE.


- 6. BOTH A "STREET TREE RELOCATION/REMOVAL PERMIT" AS ISSUED BY THE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARMENT, AND A "STREET OPENING PERMIT" AS ISSUED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, ARE REQUIRED PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF TREE RELOCATION AND/OR REMOVAL WORK. FOR ALL EXISTING TREES WITHIN WHAT WILL ULTIMATELY BE THE PUBLIC RIGHT—OF—WAY PAVEMENT AREA, BACKFILL OF ALL HOLES MUST BE INSPECTED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS INSPECTOR FOR PROPER COMPACTION.
- 7. ALL STREET TREES MUST BE AUTOMATICALLY IRRIGATED.


