



- NOTES:**
1. All construction shall be in accordance with standards and specifications No. 460 of the City of Riverside Department of Public Works.
 2. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to clear the right of way in accordance with the provisions of the law and to provide such utility including irrigation lines and appearance, and of no extra cost to the City.
 3. Traffic signals are to be moved by the City of Riverside, existing curb & curb return shall be left in place until relocation of signal facilities is completed by the city.
 4. If the contractor desires to reduce requirements on imported base material, a soil test shall be made at the contractor's expense after shovels are prepared to rough grade. Subcontractor will contact inspection division of Riverside before making any test. The City of Riverside will be notified of base material in place before paving can be installed. Results of this test must indicate that the base material is satisfactory to the inspection division.
