



- GENERAL NOTES**
1. All construction shall be in accordance with Standards and Specifications No. 461 of the City of Riverside Department of Public Works.
 2. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to clear the Right of Way in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance 100000 including irrigation lines and appurtenances, and at no extra cost to the City of Riverside.
 3. The City of Riverside will take a soil test to determine the Imported Base Material thickness after the streets have been rough graded. Prime coat and paint under will be required.
 4. Trim edge of existing paving to a clean straight line. Construct match-up paving and overlap on existing paving as directed in the field, to produce a smooth crown surface.
 5. All trees, hydrants, water meters, power poles, and irrigation stands and or boxes in the line of this construction, to be removed or relocated by the subcontractor or the utility concerned, including the City.
