



- GENERAL NOTES**
- All construction shall be in accordance with Standards and Specifications No. 461 of the City of Riverside Department of Public Works.
  - It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to clear the Right of Way in accordance with the provisions of laws in effect at each utility, including irrigation lines and appurtenances, and at no extra cost to the City of Riverside.
  - The City of Riverside will take a soil test to determine the thickness of imported base material after the streets have been prepared to rough grade.
  - Trim edge of existing pavement where new pavement joins existing paving, to a clear straight line. Construct match-up paving as shown and curbside paving as directed in the field to produce a smooth crown section.
  - Prime coat and Paint Bitumast will be required.
