



- GENERAL NOTES**
- (1) It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to clear the right of way in accordance with the provision of law as it affects each utility including irrigation lines and appurtenances and at no cost to the City.
 - (2) Construction shall be in accordance with the City of Riverside Department of Public Works, Specification No. 461 and Standard Drawings.
 - (3) Prime Coat, Seal Coat, & Paint Binder are required.
 - (4) The City of Riverside will take a soil test to determine the requirement on Imported Base Material after the street has been prepared to rough grade.
 - (5) Trim edge of existing pavement, where new pavement joins existing pavement, to a clean, straight line. Construct match-up paving as shown and overlay paving as directed in the field to produce a smooth crown section.
