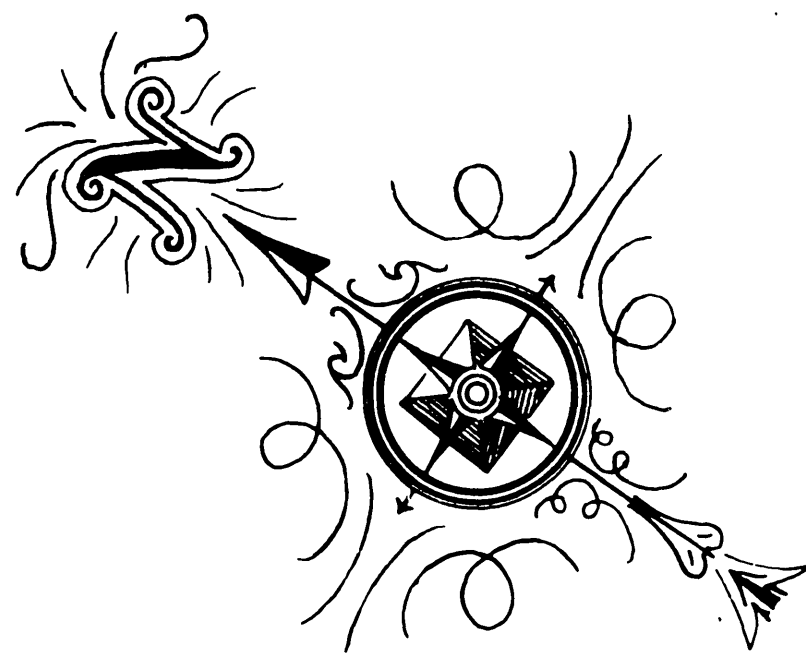


MAP OF

ARTESIA ADDITION TO ARLINGTON

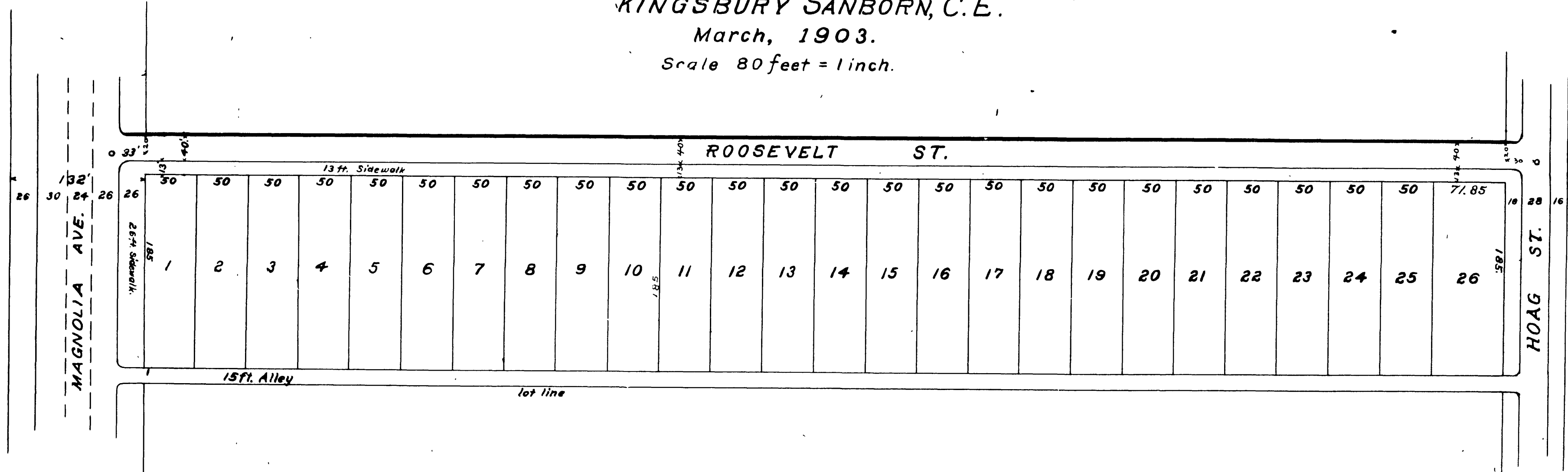
Riverside County California.
