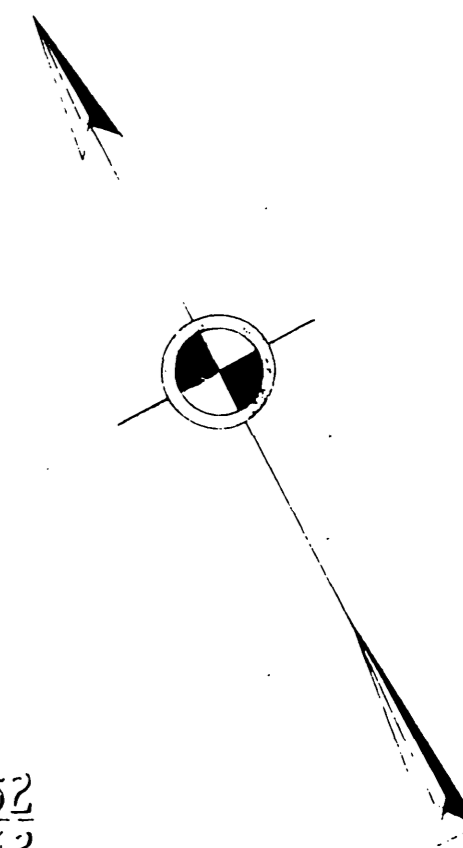


# MAP OF FILES SUBDIVISION NO. 4.

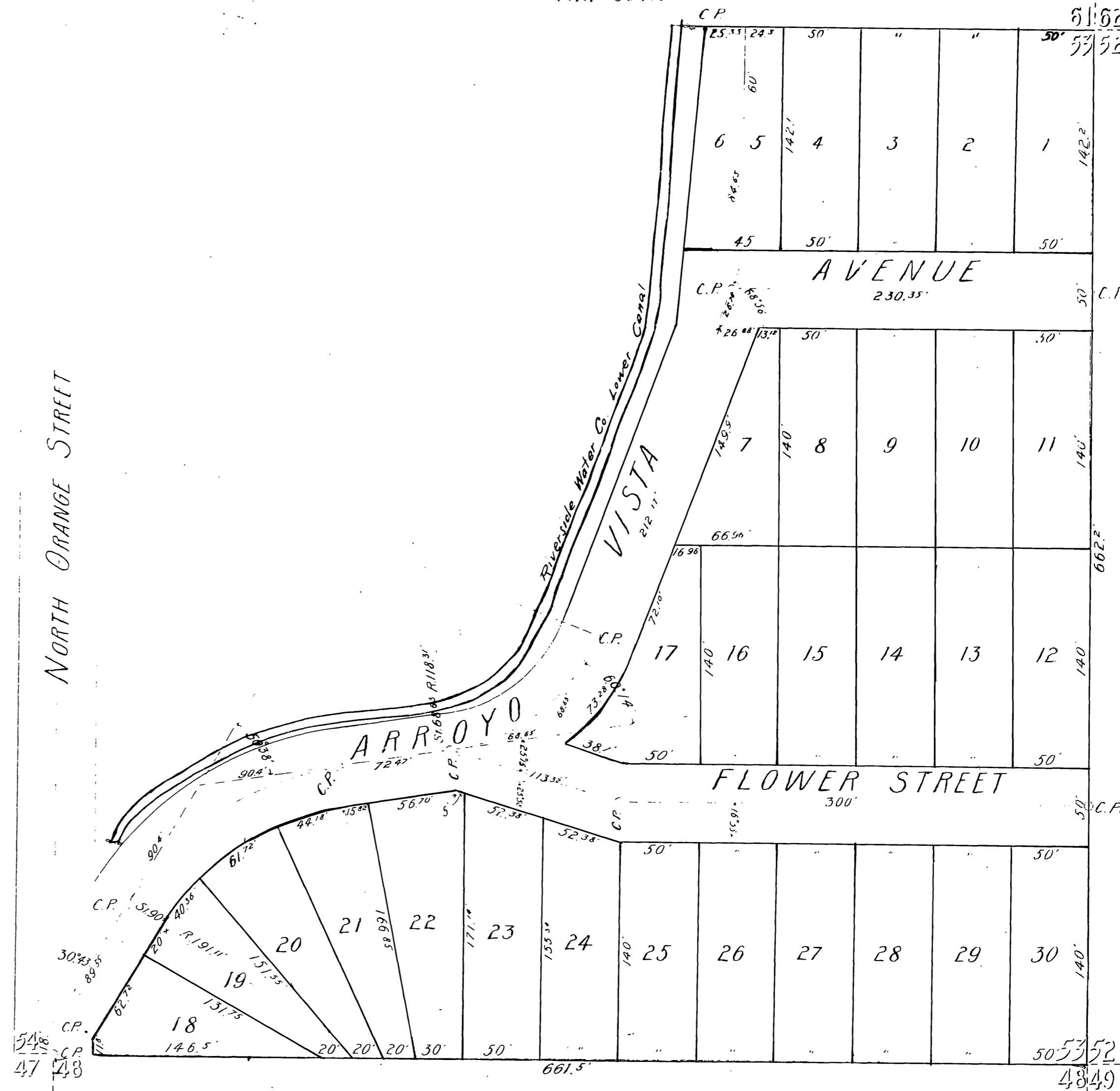
