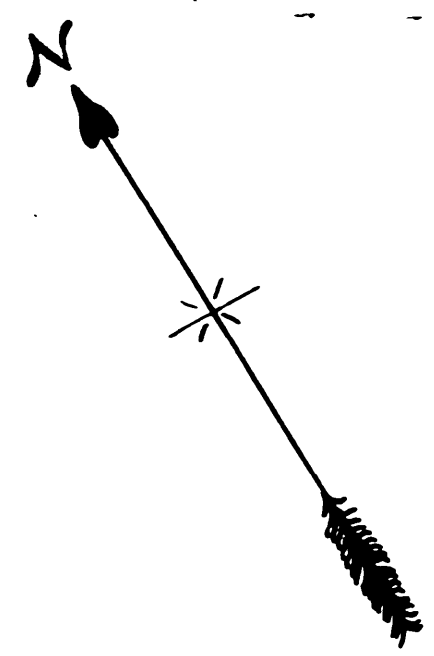
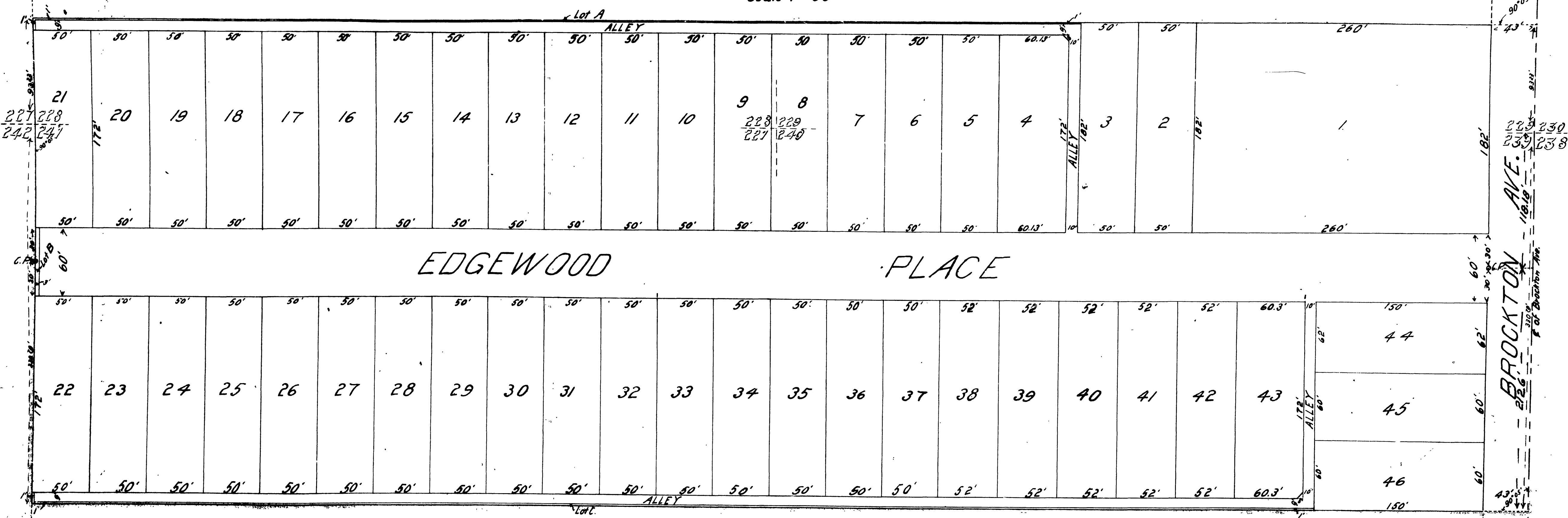


MAP OF EDGEWOOD PLACE
