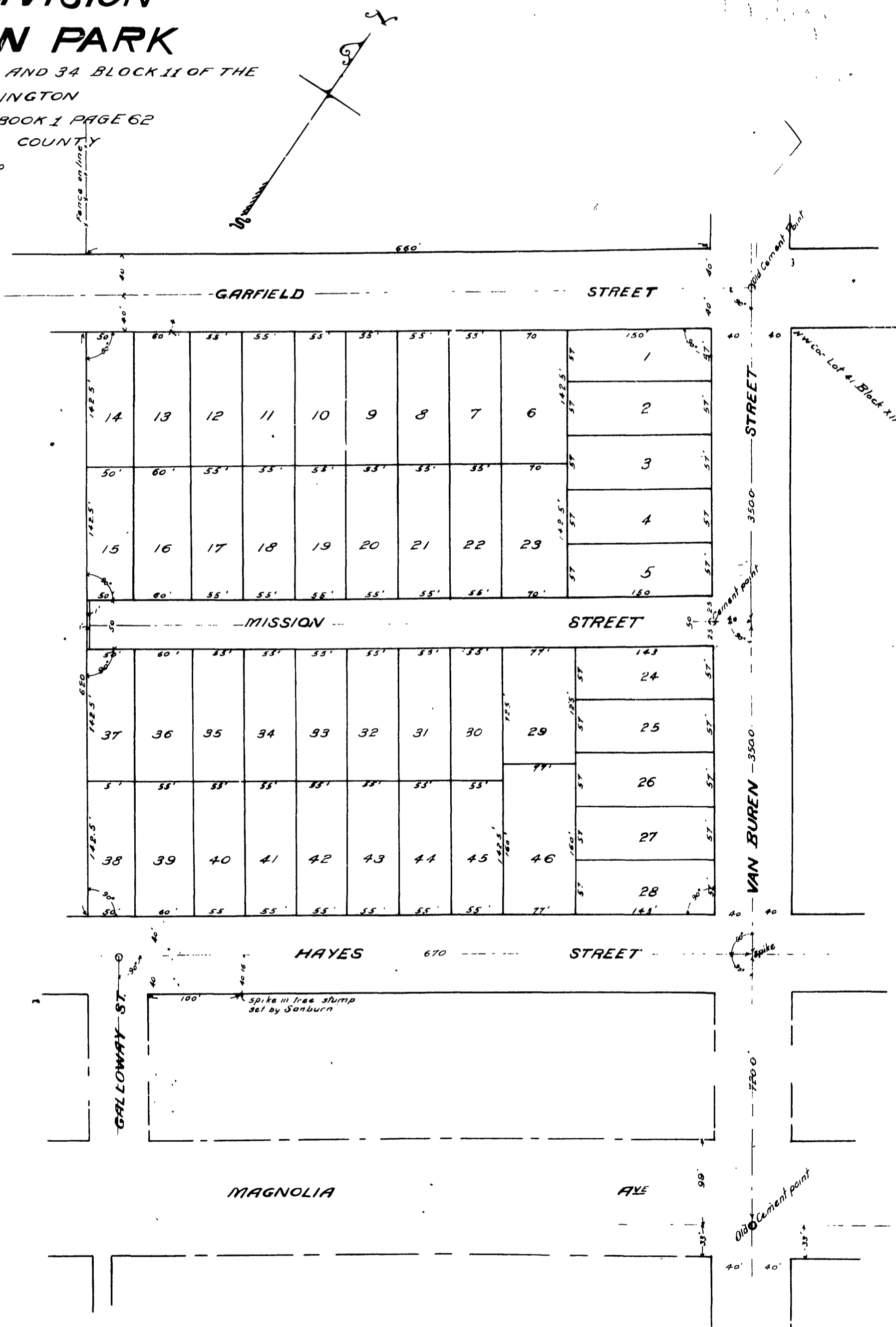


MAP SHOWING RE-SUBDIVISION OF VAN BUREN PARK
