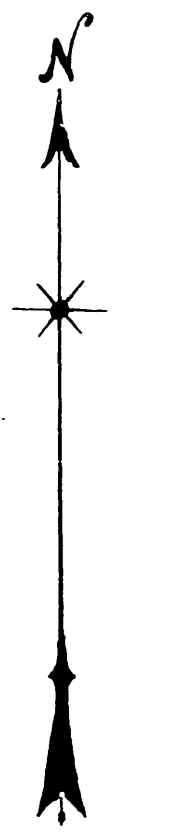


MAP OF LA COLINA TRACT

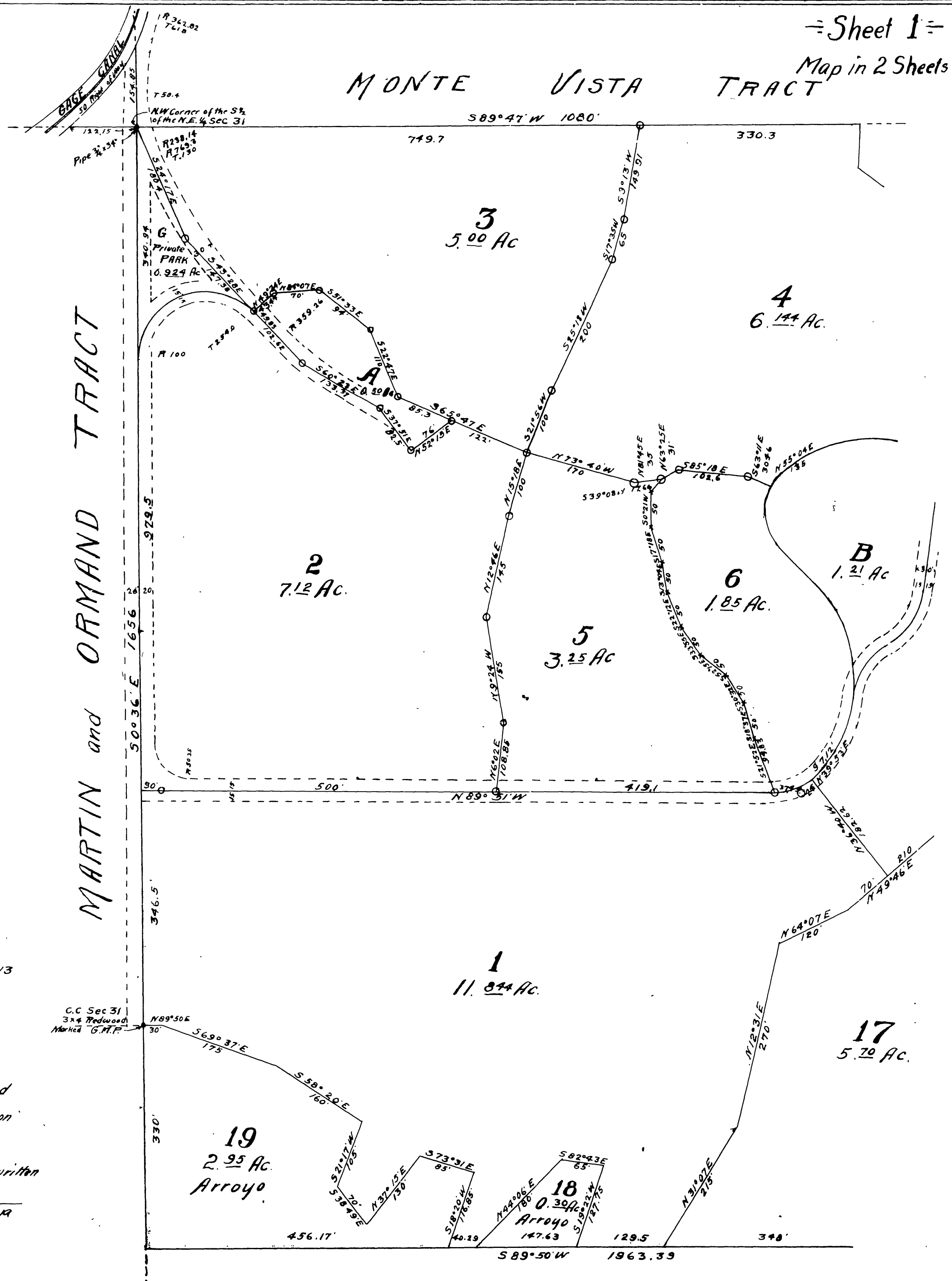

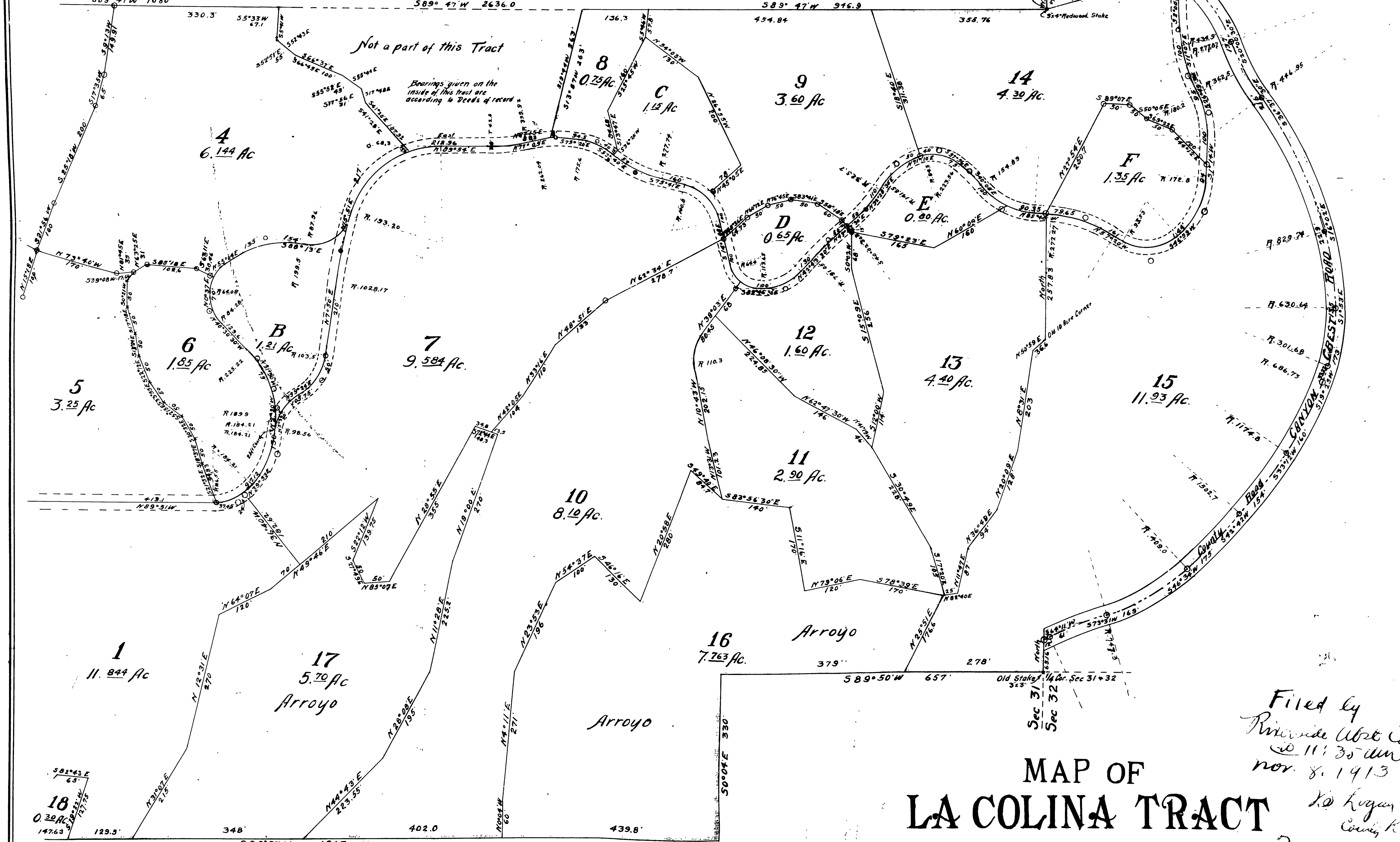
