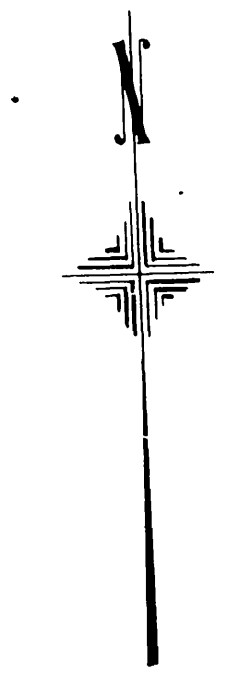
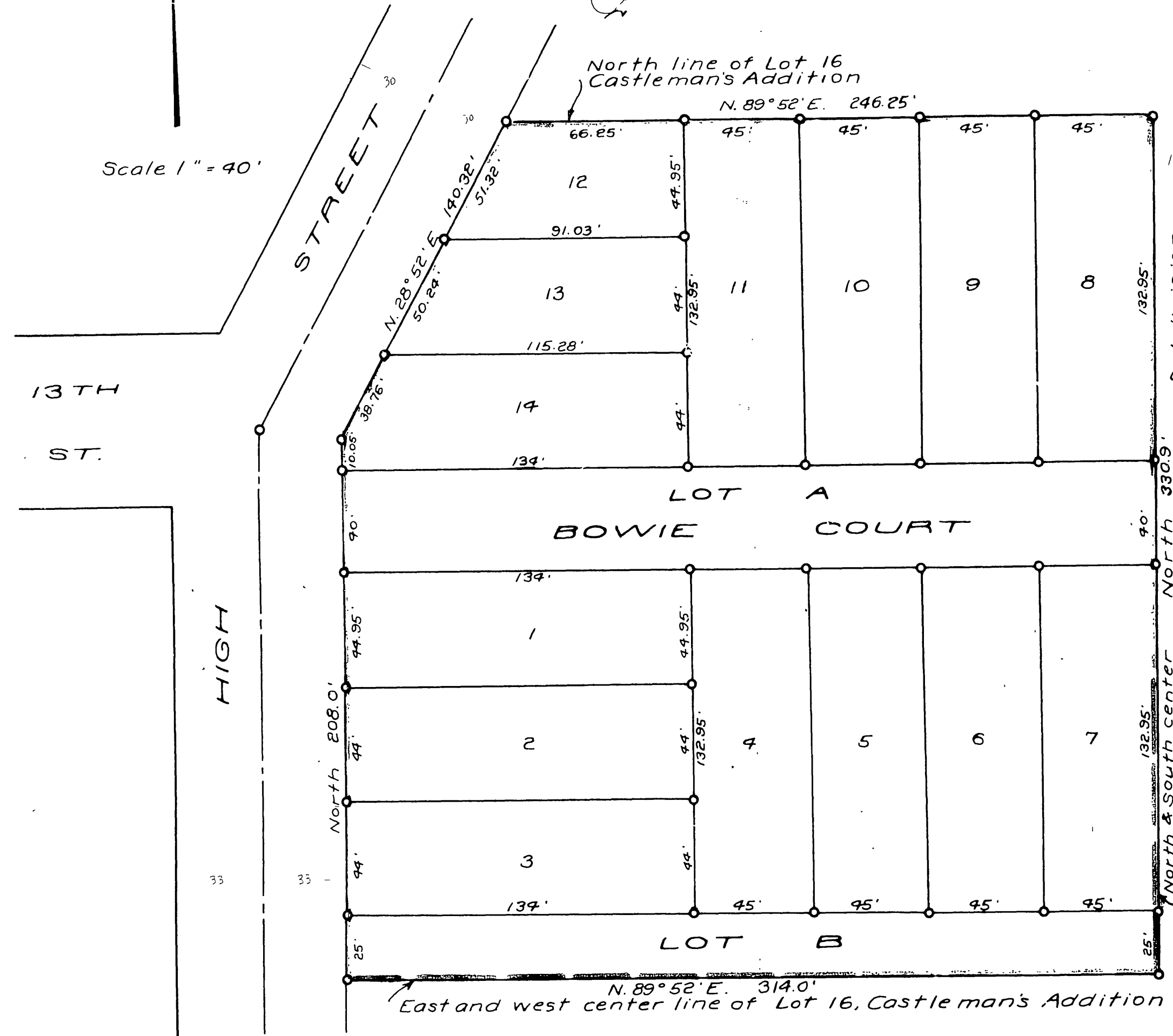


MAP OF THE HIGH ST. SUBDIVISION
