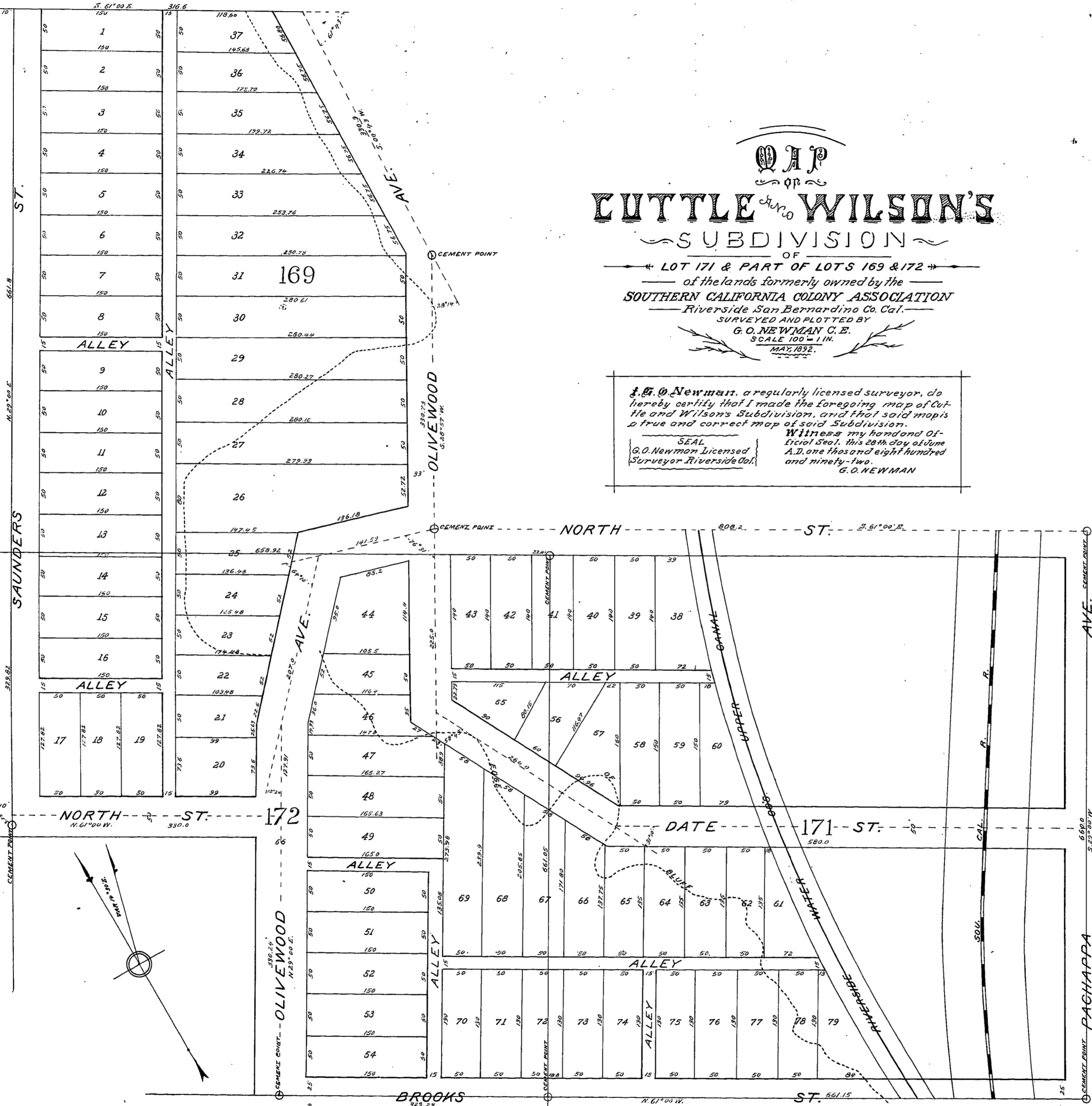

Cement points are made by boring a hole 2 inches in diameter and 2 feet deep a copper wire is placed in the center of the hole, and the same filled with a paste of pure Portland Cement and water, which soon forms a solid rock. At every corner of a block is a post 3"x4" 3 feet long marked G.O.N.S. representing the initials of H. Sanborn, my transit man.
