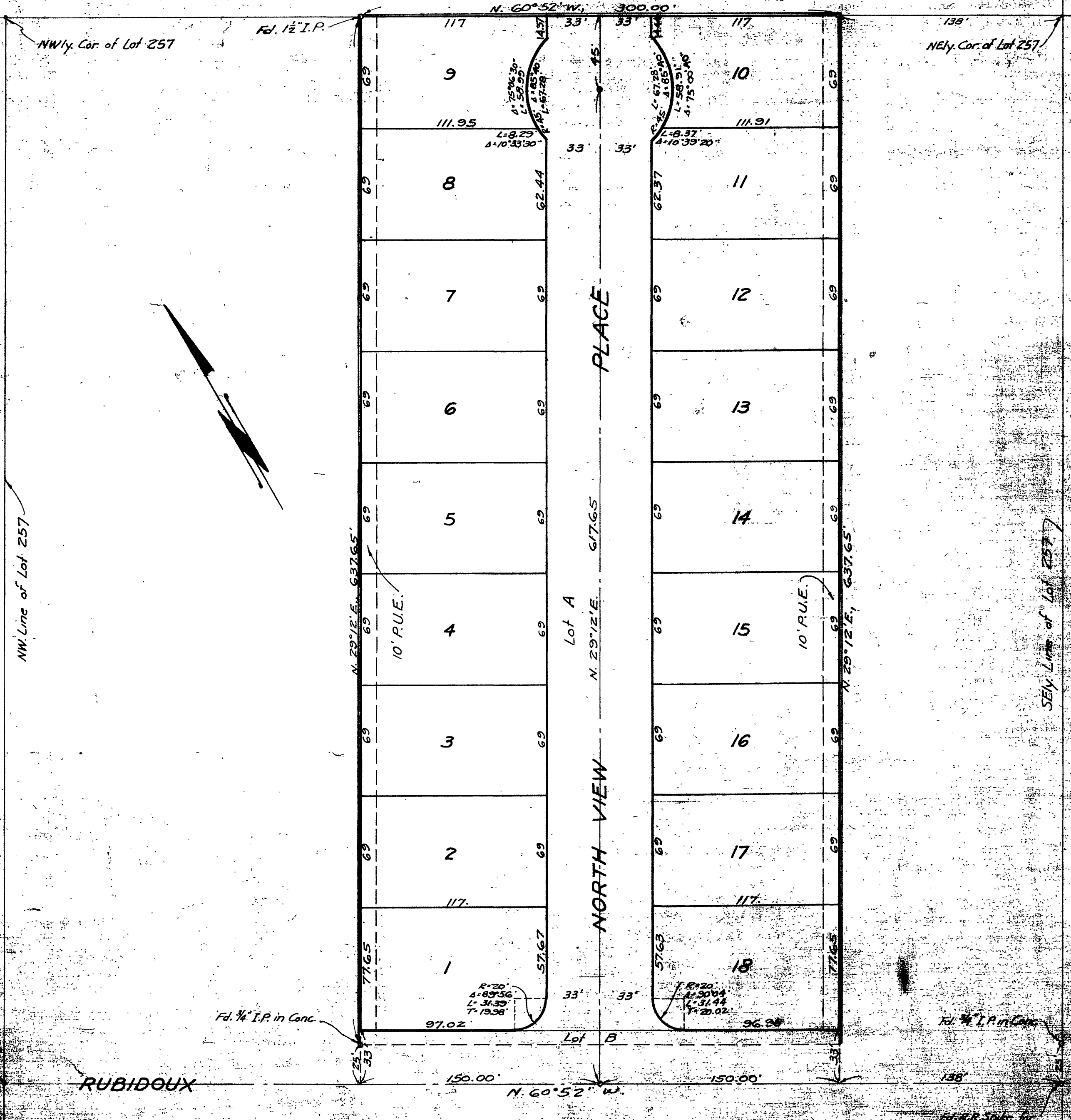
GRAND AVENUE ACRES
