

DECLARATION OF DEDICATION OF PROPERTY TO CEMETERY PURPOSES

S.L. ADLER, H.D. HALL and W.C. EVANS as Trustees of Olivewood Cemetery hereby certify and declare that the real property shown in the adjacent map is hereby dedicated exclusively to cemetery purposes, subject to all rules and regulations governing the said Olivewood Cemetery now in effect, and those hereafter adopted.

The right and privilege of any time and from time to time to re-survey, enlarge, diminish, plat and/or replat, alter in shape or size, or otherwise change any subdivision or part or portion thereof (including the right to modify and change the location of roads, drives and walkways) and to file an amended Map or Maps thereof, and to use the same for the erection of buildings, or for other purposes and uses connected with, incident or convenient to the care, preservation and preparation for the disposal or interment of human dead bodies, together with easements and rights of way over and through the real property shown in the adjacent map and the right and privilege of installing, maintaining and operating pipelines, conduits or drains for sprinklers, drainage, electric, or communication lines, or for any other proper purposes, are hereby expressly reserved.

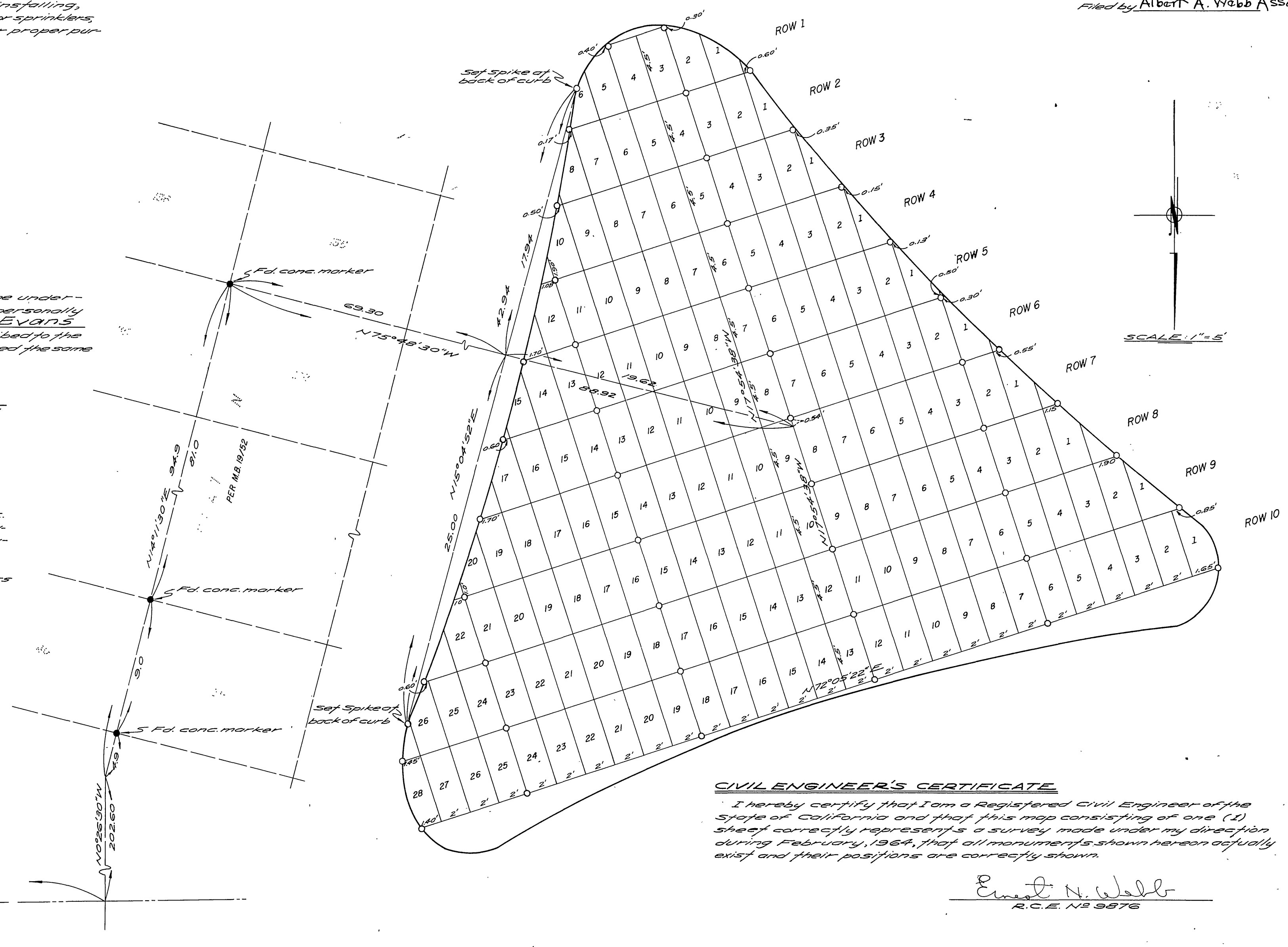
