ID Bracelet Application

The **Get Home Safe Program** offers FREE MyID Bracelet with online emergency information profiles for people with Alzheimer's and other cognitive impairment disorders. These bracelets and emergency information may help first responders locate and identify your cognitive impaired love ones if they go missing. The bracelet is linked to an electronic profile you control with a photo and emergency contact information.

It is a voluntary program, wherein at-risk residents could be entered into a database by themselves or their caregivers (with proper legal authorization). It would include a current photograph, identifying information, relevant medical information, and emergency contact information for two responsible relatives or caregivers.
