## **DUI Checkpoint Nets 6 Arrests**

Riverside, CA -- On Friday, August 20, 2010, between the hours of 6:00 PM and 12:00 AM officers from ABC, Corona Police Department, Riverside Police Department, and the University of California Riverside Police Department conducted a DUI/Driver's License checkpoint on Arlington Avenue west of Capistrano Way in the City of Riverside. Several Volunteers and Police Explorers from the Riverside Police Department were on hand to assist with the effort.

In addition to enforcing traffic laws the Department's police officers and police services representatives assisted fifteen families with the proper installation of their child safety seats.
