Two adults arrested in mail thefts

Riverside, CA -- On Saturday, October 30, 2010, at approximately 1023 hours patrol officers on routine patrol conducted a check of a suspicious vehicle in the parking lot of a liquor store in the area of 14th Street and Howard Avenue.

The officers contacted the driver who was on active parole and obtained permission to search his vehicle, which revealed several stolen checks. After further investigation, the officers learned of two additional subjects who had involvement in the mail thefts.

Officers learned the checks were taken from a USPS mail box on Sunnyside, near the Riverside Plaza. North NPC Detectives responded to the Police Station and conducted interviews of the subjects. Officers arrested one of the suspects for committing the mail thefts and possession of stolen property. The parolee was arrested on a parole violation, due to his involvement with the mail theft.
