Funeral Service for Officer Ryan B. Bonaminio to be Available for Live Internet Viewing as Well as in Archives for Viewing After Funeral

Memorial Webcasts (www.memorialwebcasts.com) today announced that the Funeral Service for Officer Ryan P. Bonaminio, Riverside, California Police Department, will be available for live viewing as well as until November 16, 2011 via its website archive. On the night of November 7, 2010, Officer Ryan Bonaminio was killed in the line of duty following his traffic stop of a suspected hit and run driver. He was 27 years old.

The Funeral Services will be held on Tuesday, November 16, 2010, 10:00 - 1:00 p.m PST at Grove Community Church in Riverside, California. An Honor Guard procession will proceed to Riverside National Cemetery for Internment immediately following the service.
