Subject: Fatal Traffic Collision – File #P10182370

Riverside, CA: On December 22, 2010 at 9:09 pm, members of the Riverside Police and Fire Departments responded to a major injury traffic collision on Tyler at Mull. The collision involved a pedestrian struck by a vehicle.

An unidentified elderly male was pushing his wheelchair westbound across Tyler at Mull in an unmarked crosswalk. A 2001 Jaguar sedan driven by eighteen year old Roman GUERRERO of Moreno Valley was driving southbound on Tyler approaching Mull. He failed to see the subject crossing the street and struck him with the front of his vehicle.

The pedestrian was taken by ambulance to Kaiser Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries. Mr. Guerrero was not injured. No other passengers were in the vehicle. Alcohol does not appear to be a factor in the collision.

The Riverside Police Department Major Accident Investigation Team (M.A.I.T.) responded to the scene and the collision is under investigation.
