Reward for information leading to arrest and conviction of bank robbery suspect

Riverside, CA – On January 21, 2010, at approximately 1040 hours, the Riverside Police Department's Communication Center received a call of a bank robbery that just occurred at 3590 Central Avenue (U.S Bank) in the city of Riverside. Upon the officers' arrival at the bank, they discovered the suspect had already fled from the immediate area.

The suspect entered the bank through the front doors and approached a bank teller's workstation. The suspect handed the teller a note demanding money. The suspect received an undetermined amount of currency from the bank teller and exited the bank through the front doors.

No one was injured during the robbery and it did not appear that the suspect had a weapon. The FBI was notified of the incident and responded to the bank to assist with the investigation.

The suspect is described as an adult white female (possible male in disguise), approximately 30-40 yrs old, heavy set, wearing a black jacket, black shirt, black gloves, black sunglasses and a possible wig. See attached photograph.

U.S. Bank is offering a reward of up to \$10,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect in this robbery.
