Homicide Suspects Sought

Riverside, CA – Shortly after midnight on October 28, 2007, the Riverside Police Communications Center received a call of “shots fired” in the 2700 hundred block of Loyola St., Riverside. Officers responded and found three gunshot victims who were subsequently transported to an area hospital for treatment. A 25-year-old male Hispanic victim was pronounced dead at the hospital; a 22-year-old female Hispanic victim suffered a minor leg wound and a 21-year-old African American male was struck multiple times, underwent surgery and is currently in stable but guarded condition.

Detectives and forensic technicians were called to the scene and they are presently conducting their investigation. The initial investigation indicates that an unknown number of uninvited Hispanic males arrived at a residential Halloween party. The unidentified Hispanic males began shooting as they left the side yard of the home. Police have no additional suspect or suspect vehicle information at this time.
