Subject of police call dies

Riverside, CA -- The subject of a reported burglary call received by Riverside Police dispatch Thursday afternoon turned out to be a man in medical distress, who later died at Riverside Community Hospital.

The reporting party said a man was pounding on a back door of a residence in the 6100-block of Bluffwood Road. Riverside Police dispatch received this call at 2:17 p.m., and responding officers arrived at 2:26 p.m. The officers located the subject sitting at a nearby residence. The male subject was handcuffed pending officers' investigation, which quickly determined that no crime had taken place. Shortly thereafter, responding officers noticed that the subject was in distress and medical aid was summoned. Both Riverside Fire Department and American Medical Response ambulance arrived at the scene and the handcuffs were removed.

Martín GASBAR PABLO, 38, of Corona, was transported by AMR ambulance and arrived just before 3 p.m. at Riverside Community Hospital, where he was treated. Gaspar Pablo died shortly before 4 p.m.
