Speeding Stolen Vehicle Crashes - Injuring Four

Riverside, CA -- On Sunday August, 23, 2009 shortly after 2 PM, an officer from the Riverside Police Department spotted a speeding 2006 Nissan Pathfinder. The Pathfinder was at a high rate of speed a couple blocks ahead of the police unit when it failed to stop for a stop sign while travelling north on Cedar at University.

A Chrysler PT Cruiser was west on University Ave with a driver and two passengers when the Pathfinder collided with the left front fender. The Pathfinder left the roadway and rolled over onto its side in the yard of a residence at the northwest corner.

All four were transported by ambulance to area hospital with complaints of pain; however there were no apparent serious injuries.

The Pathfinder returned as a Stolen Vehicle reported earlier today in Monterey Park.

The driver of the stolen vehicle; ADRIAN SANDOVAL 28 of Monterey Park, will be charged with Possession of a stolen vehicle; Reckless Driving causing injury and a Parole Violation.
