### **Stabbing Victim Transported To Local Hospital**

Riverside, CA – On Monday, September 28, 2009 at 5:15 a.m. officers from the Riverside Police Department responded to the 6200 block of Antioch Avenue after receiving reports of a stabbing.

Upon the officers' arrival they located an adult male suffering from stab wounds to the upper torso and face. The officers' also made contact with a second adult male who was believed to be the suspect. The suspect was in possession of a knife and was taken into custody without incident.

The victim was transported to Riverside Community Hospital. Once at the hospital the victim was taken into surgery and is listed in critical condition at this time.

Information received at the scene indicates the victim was inside the residence when he was attacked by his adult son. After being stabbed the victim was able to flee the residence and seek help from a neighbor.

Homicide Investigators responded and were assisted in their investigation by personnel from the Forensic Unit. The victim's son **Elio MORENO**, 26 years old was booked into Riverside County Jail for Attempt Murder.
