STOLEN AUTOMOBILE PARTS RECOVERED (2) ARRESTED

RIVERSIDE, CA – On August 1st 2016, Riverside Police Department Officers responded to a residence in the 20000 block of Camino De Gloria in the City of Riverside, Ca. reference a disturbance. Prior to officers' arrival, a male fled the location on foot. He was located hiding in a shed of a residence in the 14000 block of El Paseo in the county area of Riverside, Ca. and was taken into custody by members of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department.

Once Riverside Police Officers and Supervision arrived at the El Paseo residence, they saw numerous automobile parts they believed to be stolen from a nearby business. The Riverside P.D. East Neighborhood Policing Center Detectives, Problem Oriented Policing Officers, and Riverside P.D. Property Unit responded to the location to assist in the investigation.

Thousands of stolen automobile parts were recovered from the residence on El Paseo and another residence in the 20000 block of Avenida Hacienda. The wholesale value of the automobile parts was estimated to be worth \$95,000.00. Detectives identified two suspects, Matthew Clark and Ryan Clark, with both arrested and booked into Robert Presley Detention Center for possession of stolen property.
