## **The Club Give-Aways**

**Riverside, CA** – In the latter part of 2016, the National Insurance Crime Bureau (NICB) provided RPD with over 200 of The Club anti-theft devices to give to residents in the western part of the City, primarily targeting high-theft vehicles. Police personnel have been giving them away during various community meetings and to previous auto theft victims. This was part of the Police Department's ongoing effort to proactively combat crime, including auto theft.

Riverside residents are reminded to roll their windows all the way up, locks their doors, and use an anti-theft device such as an alarm, 'kill' switch, Lo-Jack, or GPS device.
