## **MAJOR INJURY TRAFFIC COLLISION**

**RIVERSIDE, CA** – On Tuesday, January 31, 2017 at approximately 2:16 AM the City of Riverside Emergency Dispatch center received multiple calls of a single vehicle collision into a palm tree on Brockton Ave. south of Terracina. Riverside Police and Fire personnel arrived at the scene and located a 1986 Toyota Supra with major damage which collided and uprooted a palm tree.

The driver of the vehicle, a 26 year old male resident of Riverside, was located inside the vehicle with major injuries. The driver was transported to an area hospital and is currently receiving treatment for major injuries and is currently listed in critical condition.

It appears due to the initial investigation the driver was northbound on Brockton Ave. at a high rate of speed and left the roadway colliding with two palm trees and a utility pole.

The Riverside Police Departments Major Accident Investigation Team responded and is currently investigating.
