PROBATION SEARCH LEADS TO ARRESTS

Riverside, CA – On Thursday, February 2, 2017, members of the Riverside Police Department conducted a probation search of a residence in the 5500 block of Clela Drive in the City of Riverside. Detectives recovered three stolen motorcycles, two of which were stolen from a nearby residence. They recovered two sets of snow skis with names inscribed on them, which were stolen during a nearby residential burglary. Detectives also found several firearms, including one which had a silencer attached to it. The Department's Technical Services Unit (TSU) was called to the scene due to a grenade at the residence, however, it was later determined to be inert.

21-year-old Riverside resident Alexis Lua was arrested for possession of Methamphetamine, being a felon in possession of a firearm, and probation violation. 28-year-old Gabriel Vallejo was arrested for several counts of possession of stolen vehicles, possession of stolen property, and possessing a firearm with a silencer. 22-year-old Riverside resident Juan Munoz-Aguilera was arrested for possession of Methamphetamine, resisting arrest, and probation violation.
