ARREST MADE IN HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION

RIVERSIDE, CA – On Saturday, April 7, 2018, at approximately 7:07 a.m., Riverside Police and Fire personnel responded to the 9000 block of Hope Avenue, located in the Ramona neighborhood of Riverside, regarding a deceased male subject. When they arrived, they located the subject on his bed inside the residence. He was pronounced deceased by paramedics.

Based on suspicious injuries found on the victim consistent with being involved in an assault, detectives from the Robbery – Homicide Unit and technicians from the Forensics Unit responded to assist. Their investigation led to the arrest of the victim's live-in girlfriend, who was present inside the residence when officers arrived. Teresa Demar Hunter, 61-years-old of Riverside, was later booked into the Robert Presley Detention Center for murder. Her bail was set at one million dollars.

Detectives were assisted by the Riverside County Sheriff – Coroner. The identity of the victim will be released pending their investigation and family notification. There are no other details available at this time as the investigation is still ongoing.
