MOTHER & SON TEAM ARRESTED FOR PIMPING

RIVERSIDE, CA – Detectives assigned to Riverside Police Department's Vice Unit recently received information about prostitution services being promoted on several advertising websites. They began an investigation and made contact with a woman who alleged to have been sexually exploited by two people described as mother and son. Based on this information, a search warrant was obtained for the suspects' known residence.

On Friday, May 25, 2018, detectives served the search warrant at a house in the 3600 block of Snowdrift Drive, located in an unincorporated area of Riverside County near Home Gardens. The two suspects were arrested and evidence of the alleged crimes was seized.

Angelene "Barbie" Ashley, 48-years-old, and her adult son Jordon Ashley, 26-years-old, both of Riverside, were later booked into the Robert Presley Detention Center for pimping, pandering, and keeping a house of ill fame, more commonly known as a "brothel."
