## **ATTEMPTED MURDER SUSPECT ARRESTED AND IDENTITY OF SECOND ONE SOUGHT**

RIVERSIDE, CA – On June 7, 2018, detectives from the Riverside Police Department's Robbery – Homicide Unit and the West Post-Release Accountability and Compliance Team (PACT) located and arrested Hector Carrillo Murillo, 26-years-old of Riverside, for attempted murder.

Earlier in the day around 7:00 a.m., officers responded to a local hospital after the victim was brought in with severe head injuries. Their investigation determined the victim was badly beaten by two suspects early in the morning at Myra Linn Park, located at 4540 Meredith Street in the city of Riverside. It appears the night before that numerous people and vehicles were gathered in the park late and into the early morning hours. An altercation occurred where the victim was attacked and seriously injured.

Detectives identified Murillo as one of the two suspects, but they are also looking for the second. This second suspect is only described as a Hispanic male adult in his 20's, shaved head, and with a mustache.
