SECOND SUSPECT IN ATTEMPTED MURDER ARRESTED

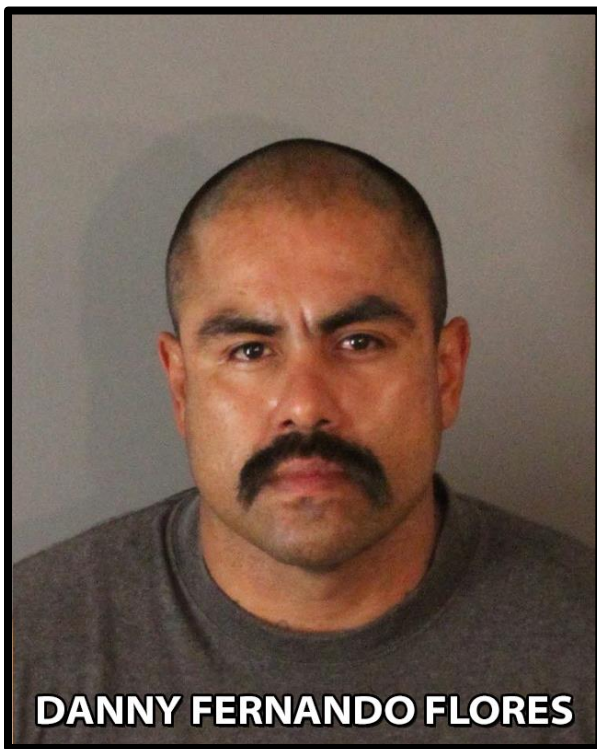
RIVERSIDE, CA – On Friday, June 15, 2018, detectives from the Riverside Police Department's Robbery – Homicide Unit and the West Post-Release Accountability & Compliance Team (PACT) arrested Danny Fernando Flores, 34-years-old of Riverside, who was identified as the second suspect in the recent attack of a victim at Myra Linn Park on June 6th. He was booked into the Robert Presley Detention Center for attempted murder and violation of Post-Release Community Supervision.

The victim was badly beaten by two suspects early in the morning on Friday, June 6th, at the park which is located at 4540 Meredith Street in the city of Riverside. It appears the night before that numerous people and vehicles were gathered in the park late and into the early morning hours. An altercation occurred where the victim was attacked and seriously injured. The next day on June 7th, Robbery – Homicide Detectives and PACT Team Officers located and arrested one of the two suspects, Hector Carrillo Murillo, 26-years-old of Riverside, for attempted murder. Then on June 15th, Danny Fernando Flores, was located and arrested.
