## SUSPECT IN CHILD SEXUAL ASSAULT ARRESTED

RIVERSIDE, CA – On Friday, September 7, 2018, at 4:30 p.m., Hubert David Edgin, 49-years-old of Riverside, was arrested for multiple counts of sexual assault of a minor under the age of ten. Detectives from the Riverside Police Department's Sexual Assault - Child Abuse Unit (SACA) have been investigating Mr. Edgin after a young child disclosed he assaulted her while at an unlicensed and family run day care provided at his home. The child was an attendee of this day care for approximately two years.

The abuse continued until a few days ago when the victim told her family of the allegations, naming Mr. Edgin as the lone suspect. Police were notified and immediately began the investigation. On Friday, detectives arrested the suspect at his residence in the 3400 block of Sun Court, located in the Eastside neighborhood of Riverside, and later booked into the Robert Presley Detention Center. Mr. Edgin is still in custody with bail set at \$1,000,000.

During their investigation, detectives learned Mr. Edgin may have had contact with other young children through his church and/or other activities. They are asking for the public's assistance with any additional information regarding Mr. Edgin and this investigation.
