I also consent to the collection of the following information into a Riverside Police Department database for access by law enforcement personnel in the enforcement of applicable trespass laws within the City of Riverside.

In addition, if the property at this address is closed to the public and posted as closed, I authorize officers to act as my agent for the purpose of requesting trespassers to leave the property and to otherwise enforce CPC 602(o).

The parties listed below will cooperate fully in prosecution of anyone who is arrested for a violation of any local or state law, including trespassing or vandalism.
