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#### GENERAL INFORMATION

The City of Riverside Municipal Code 5.90 has the following Pawn Broker/Second Hand Dealer Permit requirements.

- A. No person shall own, operate, or manage any pawnshop establishment in any location within the city without first having obtained a pawnshop business establishment permit from the chief of police. No person shall own, operate, or manage any secondhand dealer establishment in any location within the city without first having obtained a secondhand dealer establishment permit from the Chief of Police.
- B. Any person desiring to own or operate a pawnshop establishment or secondhand dealer establishment must first obtain the licenses, certificates, and permits described in sections 5.90.030, 5.90.040, and 5.90.050 in order to obtain a pawnshop business establishment permit from the Chief of Police.

#### THE FOLLOWING STEPS MUST BE COMPLETED TO OBTAIN A PAWN BROKER/SECOND HAND DEALER PERMIT WITHIN THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE:

- Review Riverside Municipal Code Chapter 5.90
- \$20,000 Two Year Non-Revocable Surety Bond (Pawnbroker)

**Submit items 3-9 along with the completed application.** Application processing may take up to 90 days. Once the application has been approved, the Pawn Broker/Second Hand Dealer Permit will be issued.
