 - Unduplicated Males 68
 - Unduplicated Females 40
 - Street Exits 65
 - Returned to Streets 10
 - Behavior / Mental Health Connections 168
 - Attempts to Connect with Drug / Alcohol Treatment -73
 - Connected to Drug / Alcohol Treatment 10

WHAT ARE THE CHALLENGES?

Housing

- HEAP Grant is bringing us 3 locations (18 beds)
- City of Lake Elsinore (working on future housing)

• Shelters

· Allowing later check in times.

Detox Faculties

• Quicker entries into Detox. (lose most due to time)

Mental Health

• County ETS to work with us. (deny treatment due to drugs)

• Law Enforcement

- All need to enforce all law (Zero Tolerance)
- · Work together
