

1 RESOLUTION NO. 22979

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED
4 ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE AN AMENDMENT TO
SECTION 403 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE AT
THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF JUNE 7, 2016.

5 WHEREAS, Article XI, Section 3, of the Constitution of the State of California, Elections
6 Code section 9255, and Government Code section 34458 authorize the City Council, on its own
7 motion, to submit to the qualified electors of the City any ballot measure by ordinance or resolution
8 proposing amendments to the City Charter at a regularly scheduled municipal election; and

9 WHEREAS, on January 12, 2016, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 22948, ordering,
10 calling, providing for and giving notice of a General Municipal Election to be held in the City of
11 Riverside on the 7th day of June, 2016, to be conducted in the City of Riverside for the purpose of
12 electing the Mayor of the City of Riverside; and

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1404 of the City Charter, the City Council desires to amend
14 Charter Section 403, Compensation, to increase the City Council member salary to eighty percent
15 (80%) of the Mayor's salary; and

16 WHEREAS, City Council wishes to submit a Charter Amendment to the voters at the June 7,
17 2016, General Municipal Election.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
19 California, as follows:

20 Section 1: The City Council, pursuant to its right and authority under California law, hereby
21 orders that the following question be submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Riverside at
22 the General Municipal Election on June 7, 2016, as referenced in Resolution No. 22948:

23 **Council Member Salary Measure.** Shall Section 403 of the City Charter be
24 amended to increase the City Council member salary to be eighty percent (80%) of
25 the Mayor's salary?

26 Section 2: That only the qualified electors of the City of Riverside are entitled to vote at
27 said election on this proposal to amend the City Charter and that if a majority of the qualified

1 electors voting on the Charter proposal votes in favor of the proposal, said proposal shall be deemed
2 approved.

3 Section 3: The City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to take all action necessary
4 to place the Measure described herein on the regular municipal election ballot for the municipal
5 election on June 7, 2016.

6 Section 4: That the form and contents of the ballots to be used at said election shall be as
7 provided by law.

8 Section 5: That in accordance with Section 10002 of the Elections Code, the Board of
9 Supervisors of Riverside County is hereby requested to consent to the Riverside County Registrar of
10 Voters rendering election services to the City of Riverside as may be requested by the City Clerk of
11 said City, the County of Riverside to be reimbursed in full for such services as are performed.

12 Section 6: That the City Clerk shall have charge of all City elections pursuant to Riverside
13 City Charter section 703(f).

14 Section 7: That the City Clerk is hereby designated the "Elections Official" for the purposes
15 of this election pursuant to Elections Code section 320(b).

16 Section 8: That based upon the foregoing authority, the City Clerk shall have charge of this
17 election and shall make all determinations necessary to conducting this election.

18 Section 9: That the City Clerk of said City shall receive the canvass of the General
19 Municipal Election and shall certify the results to the City Council, as required by law.

20 Section 10: The City Clerk is directed to transmit a copy of the measure to the City
21 Attorney. The City Attorney shall prepare an impartial analysis of the measure pursuant to Elections
22 Code section 9280, showing the effect of the measure on the existing law and the operation of the
23 measure. The analysis shall be printed preceding the arguments for and against the measure.




